
Advocate Tembeka Ngcukaitobi SC

Ngcukaitobi SC started his law degree at the University of the Transkei now Walter Sisulu University and completed the LLM degree at Rhodes University in Grahamstown. His career started at the Legal Aid Clinic in Mthatha and he later became the director of the Constitutional Litigation Unit at the Legal Resource Centre in Grahamstown before being appointed as Chief Justice Arthur Chaskalson's law clerk

He holds an LLM degree from the London School of Economics and Political Science.

Ngcukaitobi SC is the author of The Land Is Ours: South Africa's First Black Lawyers and the Birth of Constitutionalism and Land Matters: South Africa's Failed Land Reforms and the Road Ahead.
