Profile of Guest Speaker and UKZN Alumnus

Professor Bongani Mayosi

Bongani Mayosi was born in Mthatha, Eastern Cape in 1967 to a father who was a district surgeon and a mother who was a nurse.

His dream of becoming a doctor was influenced by the fun he had as boy when he was travelling with his father to visit his father's patients in the rural areas.

Bongani was home-schooled by his mother and matriculated from St John's College in Mthatha. He studied Medicine at UKZN, which was then the University of Natal. This is where he met his wife, who was also enrolled as a medical student.

Now a professor, Mayosi is Dean of the Faculty of Health Sciences at the University of Cape Town (UCT), supervising about 2 000 staff, and close to 4 000 undergraduate and postgraduate medical students combined.

Mayosi earned two medical degrees with distinction at UKZN, and worked as an intern at Livingstone Hospital in Port Elizabeth before joining UCT in 1992. He was admitted to the Fellowship of the College of Physicians of SA in 1995, and earned a doctoral degree at the University of Oxford in the UK in 2003.
