Professor Eugene Coyle is Dean of the Military Technological College of the Sultanate of Oman. He was previously a faculty member at Dublin Institute of Technology over a period of several years, and held the positions including Head of School of Electrical Engineering Systems and Head of External Research Engagement before taking up his current post in Oman. Dr Eugene spent one academic year (2011-12) as a visiting Fulbright Scholar at Purdue University's' Global Policy Research Institute in Indiana. His research at Purdue resulted in a book titled "Understanding the Global Energy Crisis".
